decade or so after it was completed, Napoleon Bonaparte and his Grand Army invaded and he had the Quadriga statue shipped off to Paris. In 1814, when the Prussians were able to return the favour by capturing Paris, they took the statue back to Berlin and re-installed it - but with the addition of the Prussian 'Iron Cross', to remind the French that they lost. The unfortunate, but well-travelled, statue was removed yet again during the

Communist era. In addition to the Prussian Kings, Napoleon and the Communists, the Brandenburg Gate has been used as a political grandstand by such varied characters as Hitler (1933), and by US Presidents John F Kennedy (1963) & Ronald Reagan (1987). But finally, the people of Berlin - the real owners - took it back for themselves at the fall of the Berlin wall in 1989. The Goddess of Victory was finally restored to her rightful place at the reunification of Germany, in 1990.
